- (1) In line with the enforcement of the Act on Establishment of Enhanced Environment for Youth's Safe and Secure Internet Use (hereinafter, Act on Youth's Safe and Secure Internet Use), you are required to report if the subscriber is under the age of 18.
- (2) If the subscriber is under the age of 18, you must apply for and use ANSHIN-Control by i-FILTER by enforcing the Act on Youth's Safe and Secure Internet Use.
- (3) Using the Internet (including Internet access via wireless LAN) may lead to opportunities to access harmful information that impedes young people's healthy development. In addition, pay attention to the following risks arising from Internet use.
 1. Many cases of young people caught up in crimes by accessing online dating sites, adult sites, or sites with violent expressions.
 2. Exchanging information with strangers through profile-sharing websites and social media services may result in your information leaking or having your privacy infringed upon through the unauthorized reproduction of photos.
 3. The irresponsible posting of individuals on websites, such as blogs and bulletin boards, can lead to slander or defamation and could be charged.
 4. There may be cases of being accused of forcible obstruction of business or threats due to posting threats online out of curiosity.
- (4) ANSHIN-Control by i-FILTER does not eliminate all of the above risks. When a minor is going to use a cellular phone, ensure that you clarify the intended use, how it should be used, and agree on rules for screen time and fees, etc.
